We require a regular, full-time instructor to teach 8 sections per year of basic and intermediate level Japanese starting Fall 2010. As an instructor, the successful candidate will also attend meetings and participate in committee work.

Faculty members in the Department of Modern Languages at Douglas College are committed to the Natural Communicative Approach for teaching beginner and intermediate language courses. Vocabulary and grammatical concepts are introduced in the natural context of the language. The courses are designed to develop listening comprehension, speaking, reading and writing skills. Students are also introduced to the cultural aspects of the language taught.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree with native level fluency in written and oral Japanese. Experience in teaching Japanese as a second language at the post-secondary level will be considered an asset. Preference will be given to the candidate who has a demonstrated ability to use the Natural Communicative Approach.
