## Program Information

### Weekly Contact Hours

Morning Classes: 3 hours X 5 days = 15 hours

Afternoon Activities and Workshops: 2 hours X 5 days = 10 hours

### Typical Week (Monday to Friday)

The program features classes, afternoon activities and weekly organized visits to different locations around the Greater Vancouver region. Each activity allows you to speak and listen to English in community settings and is designed to improve your oral communication skills in an intensive language learning setting. Some optional activities are offered on weekends.

### Optional Activities

Optional activities include outings to some special destinations such as Stanley Park, Granville Island Public Market and North Shore parks.

The program is offered at the New Westminster Campus.

### Program Fee: \$2,050 CDN (including \$500 non-refundable deposit)

Program fee includes: Full day program (Monday to Friday, weekly fieldtrips, social-cultural activities

### Refund Policy

A \$500 CDN deposit must accompany your application. The \$500 deposit is non-refundable. The balance (\$1,550 CDN) of the program fee is due on or before Friday, July 9, 2010. No refund will be issued after July 9.
