The Recreation Leader 1 – Youth Worker builds relationships with youth and refers youth at risk to various social service agencies. The ideal candidate will have solid experience working with high risk youth in a variety of situations and able to problem solve accordingly.

Shifts may be available evenings Monday to Friday (6:00pm - 10:00pm). Salary is \$22.08/ hour + 12% in lieu of benefits (Pay Grade 15, 2011 Rates).

Job Requirements:

- Qualifications for this position include experience with youth at risk in a variety of different settings;
- a two year Community Recreation program from a recognized community college is also considered an asset.
- Knowledge of organized community recreation principles and practices is preferred, as well as the ability to organize, coordinate and provide leadership in a variety of social, cultural and recreational programs.
- Other attributes desired include strong communication and public relations skills, and experience with program planning, development, implementation and evaluation.
- Current standard first aid and C.P.R. certificates are desirable.
