## LOOKING FOR SHORT-TERM SKILLS CERTIFICATE TRAINING TO GIVE YOU THE JOB SEARCH EDGE?

Employment Skills Access (ESA) is offered through The Ministry of Advanced Education and Labour Market Development. Unemployed individuals (those not receiving Employment Insurance currently, or in past 3-5 years) can access training in local public post-secondary institutions to strengthen job-specific skills.

### PROGRAM ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS:

ESA supports unemployed individuals who are non-EI clients. The ESA initiative focuses on groups that are under-represented in the labour market including immigrants, Aboriginal persons, persons with disabilities, youth, older workers and previously self-employed persons.
