- **preference to students entering the third year of the Bachelor of Business Administration program and**

Four awards of \$5,000 each available:

- **preference to students entering the fourth year of the Bachelor of Business Administration program:**

Awards are to be distributed as follows:

- **Preference will be given to candidates with a minimum semester GPA of 3.0 or better;**
- **Preference will be given to candidates in financial need;**
- **Recipients must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits with preference to students enrolled in 15 credits;**
- **Recipients must be either Canadian, Permanent Resident or Convention Refugee**
- **Recipients must be enrolled in any major of the Bachelor of Business Administration program**
- **Recipients will receive up to \$2,500 in the Fall semester (9 credits \$1,500, 12 credits \$2,000, 15 credits \$2,500). Provided award winners remain enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits and maintain their GPA, they will be eligible to receive up to \$2,500 in the proceeding Winter semester.**
- **If a recipient does not maintain the required GPA he/she will not be eligible to receive the second portion of his/her award in the Winter semester. The forfeited \$2,500 will be awarded to another student who meets the award criteria and who has not already received the Frank Giustra Commerce and Business Award.**
- **Students who have received the Frank Giustra Commerce and Business Scholarship are not eligible to receive the Frank Giustra Commerce and Business Award in the same academic year.**
