EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY - #A216 SUMMER CAMP LEADER (PLAYGROUND LEADER 1)

Summer Camp Leaders are required for various summer camps including programs for preschool, school-aged children and youth.

Candidates must be able to lead a wide variety of programs and activities; including leading sports, arts and crafts, games, and out-trips. Candidates should be highly enthusiastic and capable of motivating and encouraging others. They are responsible for promoting a positive, healthy environment for campers and displaying leadership skills. Candidates should have a demonstrated ability to exercise good judgment and will be responsible for ensuring the safety and quality of the camp program. Candidates must also be able to work effectively with children; closely and cooperatively with parents, other daycamp leaders, facility staff and volunteers.

The summer session runs between July 3 and August 31, 2012. Leaders are expected to be available on weekdays for the entire session. Hours of work will vary according to placement and registration numbers. Union shifts may vary from 4 hours per day up to 40 hours per week. Applicants who apply will also be considered for contract camp employment.

- Employment is dependent upon program registration
- All applicants must be available for an interview on Thursday March 8th, 2012
- Successful applicants must be available for a 16 hour paid training course on Saturday June 23rd AND Sunday June 24th
- All applicants are required to have a Criminal Record Check completed through their local police detachment

Preference will be given to candidates who have experience working with children and who hold current Standard First Aid and CPR Level C certificates. Previous daycamp experience is desirable. Experience leading arts and crafts, dance, and sports would be an asset.
