EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY - #A217 SUMMER CAMP LEADER (PLAYGROUND LEADER 2)

Summer Camp Leaders are required for various summer camps including programs for preschool, school-aged children and youth.

Candidates must be able to prepare and lead a wide variety of programs and activities; including leading sports, arts and crafts, games, and out-trips. They are responsible for creating detailed lesson plans and camp itineraries, working within a camp budget and making program bookings. Candidates must have the ability to demonstrated strong risk management and supervisory skills; implementing policies and procedures, and supervising and mentoring other daycamp leaders and volunteers. They must work courteously and effectively with the public while providing safe, quality daycamp programs. Candidates must also be able to work effectively with children, closely and cooperatively with parents and facility staff.

The summer session runs between July 3 and August 31, 2012. Leaders are expected to be available on weekdays for the entire session. Hours of work will vary according to placement and registration numbers. Union shifts may vary from 4 hours per day up to 40 hours per week. Applicants who apply will also be considered for contract camp employment.

- Employment is dependent upon program registration
- All applicants must be available for an interview on Thursday March 8th, 2012
- Successful applicants must be available for a 16 hour paid training course on Saturday June 23rd AND Sunday June 24th
- All applicants are required to have a Criminal Record Check completed through their local police detachment

Preference will be given to candidates who have a minimum of 2 years experience working with children in a variety of settings and who hold current Standard First Aid and CPR Level C certificates. Previous daycamp experience is required. Experience leading arts and crafts, dance, sports and ESL programs would be an asset.
