Elective notes (1-4):

Note 1: requirements include the successful completion of content in Canadian Geography (min. 3 credits) and Canadian History (min. 3 credits).

Note 2: Canadian content requirement cannot be met with completion of Physical Geography.

Note 3: minimum of 9 credits must be completed from non-SPSC upper level (3000/4000 level) courses. Upper-level courses are those courses where students have completed at least 6 credits of preparatory work in the subject area.

Note 4: Maximum 3 elective credits from Sport Science courses.

Note 5: each fieldwork course is one (1) credit.

Note 6: lab science approved for entry into applicable Bachelor of Education PDP.
